*Another grandmom of one of our older boys talked about how well he is doing in school, while before he was not performing well in school. She said, "When not taking care of the stomach (meaning when not eating), he was sleeping in class. Now he has no stress; he is in good health." She is very thankful for the sponsors!!

*Another guardian sent thanks and asked about the chance for full time care...

*A Kuka, a grandfather, commented about his granddaughter's reading and writing – he thanks you. He sees God doing great things!

*A guardian aunt commented on one of our littlest guys: before he was not good at home, but now he is obedient, the best, he is doing well, and he is healthy.

*Many share their additional needs, needs of other children, or ask for us to employ someone they know.

I only wish I could infuse for you the passion and compassion. We juggle a carnival of communication, as some of our older guardians only speak their mother tongue; their mother tongue is translated to Swahili, then to English. They care about these children and about their future. Many of them wish we could take the children full time NOW! They have many questions... some have yet to complete the collection of paperwork that will be needed for us to take the children through the court process where they become Miracle House children full time. I'm thankful for the rapport I've been able to build with these precious people. On a funny note, the last time we met they tried to talk me into taking all of them in to care for as well – I laughed and told them they were too old, and I couldn't be their mum, too! Some guardians are an older sibling, and these I would love to employ. We're constantly praying for God's direction!
